



# COLLEGE GIRLS' SUMMER UNIFORM

PHASING OUT PERIODS: Grey skirt until November 2018. Old PE uniform and tracksuit until November 2017.

The intention is to have students' uniform looking neat so that they can represent the school with pride. Interpretation rests with the Management of the School and is subjective by nature.

## OLD (Phasing Out)

All clothing must be the appropriate size and in good repair.



Grey skirt, acceptable, modest length; short white socks.

White, short-sleeved school blouse with school badge, not to be tucked in (Plain WHITE vest underneath).

Polished black school shoes (No pumps, tackies or fashion shoes).

School blazer, grey jersey/pull-over may be worn on colder days.

NO hoodies or other tops.

Grade 12s are allowed to wear St George's Matric Tops.

## NEW (Phasing In)

All clothing must be the appropriate size and in good repair.



Tartan skirt, acceptable, modest length with black hot pants and white bobby socks. OR Grey school pants with grey socks.

White, short-sleeved school blouse with school badge, not to be tucked in (Plain WHITE vest underneath).

Polished black school shoes (No pumps, tackies or fashion shoes).

School blazer, grey jersey/pull-over may be worn on colder days.

NO hoodies or other tops.

Grade 12s are allowed to wear St George's Matric Tops.

## PE UNIFORM

All clothing must be the appropriate size and in good repair.



PE T-shirt and black school PE short.

Black school cap.

No tights or other sport clothes.

White ankle socks (no hidden/secret socks) and black sport shoes (no fashion tackies or sneakers).

New school track-suit and/or new fleece top in winter.

NO hoodies or other tops.

**OPTIONAL ITEMS**  
Mid-thigh black tights.

Plain WHITE vest underneath the PE shirt.

WHITE short sleeved second skin underneath in the summer or a WHITE long sleeved second skin underneath the PE shirt in the winter.

## HAIR

Appropriate for school uniform. Washed and combed. All shoulder length/long hair and braids tied back with simple white, red, black or natural hair ties. Weaves: natural hair colour and neat. No hair-colouring; no fashion styles; no shaving.

## JEWELRY

Watches are permitted. Single plain stud or sleeper in the lobe of the ear (girls only) permitted. No other jewelry permitted. Medic alert bracelets are permitted.

## GROOMING

No make-up. No visible tattoos. UNDERWEAR: white, black or flesh colour. NAILS: Short, clean and neat. Colourless nail polish - no gel or acrylic nails.

## CIVVIE DAYS/OUTINGS

Acceptable, modest clothing. SWIMSUITS: One-piece (Girls). TRAVELLING: Jeans and new PE shirt.

## SUMMER UNIFORM

*All clothing must be the appropriate size and in good repair.*



Grey school trousers and plain black belt with plain buckle; trousers **MAY NOT BE MODIFIED**.

White short-sleeved shirt (tucked in) with school badge. Top button undone. No sleeves rolled up.

Polished black school shoes (no tackies or fashion shoes), grey socks (no white or any other colour socks).

School blazer, grey jersey/pullover may be worn on colder days.

NO hoodies or other tops.

Grade 12s are allowed to wear St George's Matric Tops.

### OPTIONAL ITEMS

Plain white vest or short-sleeved T-shirt under school shirt.



## PE UNIFORM

*All clothing must be the appropriate size and in good repair.*



PE T-shirt (top button undone) and black school PE short.

Black school cap.

No tights or other sport clothes.

White ankle socks and black sport shoes (no fashion tackies or sneakers).

New school tracksuit and/or new fleece top in winter.

NO hoodies or other tops.

### OPTIONAL ITEMS

Mid-thigh black tights.  
Plain WHITE vest underneath the PE shirt.

WHITE short sleeved second skin underneath in the summer or a WHITE long sleeved second skin underneath the PE shirt in the winter.

## HAIR

Washed and combed. Short, neatly cut. Fades no more than 2 steps. No fashion styles, panga cuts, etc. No braids and hair colouring.

## JEWELRY

Watches are permitted. No other jewelry permitted. Medic alert bracelets are permitted.

## GROOMING

Face should be clean shaven. No side-burns. No visible tattoos. NAILS: Short, clean and neat.

## CIVVIE DAYS/OUTINGS

Acceptable, modest clothing. SWIMSUITS: Board shorts. TRAVELLING: Jeans and new PE shirt.

## OLD (Phasing Out)

All clothing must be the appropriate size and in good repair.



Red, white and grey tartan skort, acceptable, modest length; short white socks.

White, short-sleeved school blouse with school badge, not to be tucked in (Plain WHITE vest underneath).

Polished black school shoes or black sandals (No pumps, tackies or fashion shoes).

Black fleece top - discontinued.

## NEW (Phasing In)

All clothing must be the appropriate size and in good repair.



Tartan skirt, acceptable, modest length with black hot pants and short white socks.

White, short-sleeved school blouse with school badge, not to be tucked in (Plain WHITE vest underneath).

Polished black school shoes or black sandals (Grade 1-3 only) No pumps, tackies or fashion shoes.

Grey jersey/pull-over may be worn on colder days.

NO other tops.

A new fleece top and black soft shell blazer will be available for winter.

### SUMMER STEP-OUTS

To be worn at all formal school events, e.g. Awards evenings.

Tartan skirt, white school blouse with polished black school shoes and white ankle school socks. Jersey/pull-over optional.

Black school cap.

No tights or other sport clothes.

## SUMMER UNIFORM

*All clothing must be the appropriate size and in good repair.*

Grade 1-6: Grey shorts. Polished black school shoes, grey school socks or black sandals (Only Grade 1-3).

Grade 7: Grey school trousers and plain black belt with plain buckle; trousers MAY NOT BE MODIFIED.

Grade 1-7: White short-sleeved shirt (tucked in) with school badge (Top button undone). Plain white short-sleeved T-shirt under school shirt optional.

Grey jersey/pull-over may be worn on colder days.

NO other tops. Black fleece top - discontinued.

A new fleece top and soft shell blazer will be available for winter.

### SUMMER STEP-OUTS

To be worn at all formal school events, e.g. Awards evenings.

Grey shorts (Grade 1-6) or pants, white school short-sleeved shirt with polished black school shoes and grey school socks. Jersey/pull-over optional.



## PE UNIFORM

Black school cap.

No tights or other sport clothes.
